Assess Your Project:

- Is your project located in Philadelphia?
- Is your building commercial, industrial or multifamily?
- Are you installing at least \$100,000 of energy efficiency, water conservation, clean energy, indoor air quality or resiliency measures?
- Do you think your project will help you save money on your utility bills?
- Is the building up to date on its taxes?
- If your project is new construction, will your installed measures be above energy code requirements?
